- [Helsinki University Press](#) and [Stockholm University Press](#): both use [Ubiquity Press](#), as well as indexing all books in the [Directory of Open Access Books](#). Helsinki University Press also uses [JSTOR \(Business Models for OA Books\)](#).
- [Language Science Press](#): Copies are listed in the [Directory of Open Access Books](#), [Google Books](#), Amazon, VLB, [Zenodo](#), EBSCO and Proquest. Language Science Press has also contract with Scopus ([LSP website](#))
- [Open Book Publishers](#): Uses nine metadata aggregators and eleven ebook retail/distribution platforms. Books are also made available via textbook platforms, including [MERLOT](#), [Open Textbook Library](#), [BC Campus OpenEd](#), [College Open Textbooks](#) and [OER Commons \(Jisc Interviews, Rupert Gatti\)](#).

## Print distribution

- [African Minds](#): Distributes print copies in South Africa via [Sula Book Distributors](#), and internationally via [African Books Collective](#).
- [Mattering Press](#), [Open Book Publishers](#), [Stockholm University Press](#): Each distributes print copies via [Lightning Source](#). [Open Book Publishers](#) additionally uses [GOBI \(Business Models for OA Books\)](#).
